

Endangered and Invasive Species Brochure

Your task is to research the two species that live in the same location (chosed from the list below). You are to organize and present the information about your two species in the form of a tri-fold, educational/informative brochure. Your brochure should include the following:

- Cover: a picture or sketch of both species, the common name, and the scientific name of each
- Location and description of the location where the species both live
- Information on the feeding behavior/diet of both species
- Information on noteworthy behaviors: number of offspring, body size, habitat requirements, etc.
- Other taxonomically related species
- Reasons for the listing of your endangered species, and the year it was listed
- Steps taken to preserve the endangered species
- Steps taken to remove invasive species
- Any connections between the invasion of the introduced species and the decline in population of the endangered species
- A list of sources where you found your information (bibliography)
